Dress Up Days:

Monday, October 14—Rhyme without Reason

- Dress up with a friend and come up with two costumes that rhyme but have nothing in common

Tuesday, October 15: Career Day

- Homecoming t-shirt and blue jeans (no spirit or uniform shirts with jeans)

Important Information

- Students who choose not to participate in the dress days must wear their school uniform.
- Students should exercise good judgment when planning attire.
- If students decide to wear a “onesie,” they must have shorts and a t-shirt beneath it.
- If wearing Nike shorts, student must have on leggings underneath.
- If wearing leggings, student must have on shorts over leggings.
- Shorts/skorts must follow parish guidelines for length.
- No masks or helmets may be worn to cover up entire face
- Face painting is allowed, but the entire face cannot be painted. (ex: you can paint whiskers but not a cat face OR you can put blue/gold but can't fully cover entire face)
- Hair coloring/spray paint is allowed if it fits with your character's color scheme. Hair coloring cannot be permanent.
- Jeans are only allowed if part of your costume. No rips, tears, or holes.
- No midriff shirts, shirts with inappropriate language/sayings, symbols, pictures.
- No slides/crocs
- Teachers: If in doubt about a student's dress, send student to the office
